Provision of cloud services and infrastructure for a range of TCorp systems 'Services').

Estimated amount payable to the contractor: Approximately \$770,000.00 in FY 21-22.

Description of any allowable variations to that amount:

The allowable variations to this amount are:

- 1. Adjustment to fees made by AWS, in the event that there are changes to Services as requested by TCorp.
- 2. AWS may increase or change fee amounts for service offerings, by providing 30 days' notice to TCorp.

There are no renegotiation provisions under this agreement.

AWS was selected to provide the Services because:

- It satisfied mandatory agency requirements under the NSW government ICT services scheme;

- Its known experience and capabilities, reputation and performance record in the market (including previous experience with TCorp); and
- Understanding of TCorp's technology infrastructure environment and business.
